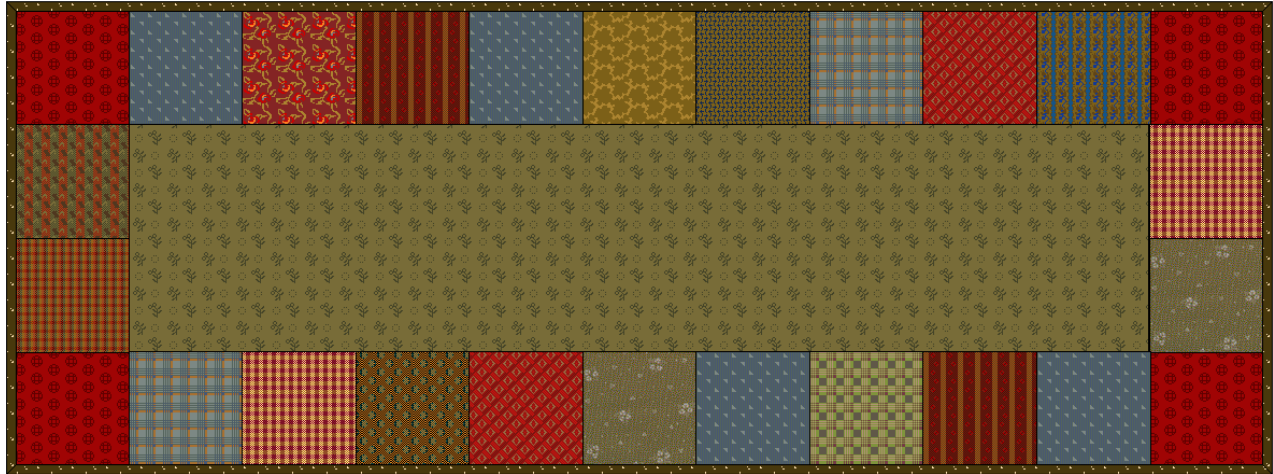




# Merry Christmas Table Runner



Finished size: 14" x 38 1/2"

## Materials needed:

Scrap squares of assorted red, green and blue prints, plaids or checks, at least 4" x 4". Some prints can be repeated.

1/4 yard of green print

1/2 yard of backing fabric

1/4 yard of binding print

Cotton batting

## Directions:

From the assorted red, blue and green scraps:

Cut 26 squares, 4" x 4"

From the green print:

Cut 1 rectangle, 7 1/2" x 32"

1. Sew 9 squares together into a row. Repeat. (Make 2 rows of 9 squares.)
2. Attach one row of squares to the top of the green rectangle. Press. Add the second row

of squares to the bottom of the rectangle and press.

3. Sew 4 squares together into a row. Repeat. (Make 2 rows of 4 squares.)
4. Attach each row to either side of the runner. Press.
5. Cut backing and batting several inches larger than quilt top. Layer top with batting and backing.
6. Quilt as desired. Add binding according to your favorite binding method.
